# BHIS following the Guidelines for Digital Education - Pragyata

- Synchronous: This is real-time teaching and learning that can happen collaboratively
  and at the same time with a group of online learners or even individually, and usually
  a teacher, or some method of instant feedback; examples of synchronous learning
  are online teaching through video conference (two-way video, one-way video, twoway audio), audio conference (two way audio) using satellite or telecommunication
  facilities.
- Asynchronous: This is anytime, anywhere learning but not connected on real time, for example, emails, SMS, MMS, surfing e-content on DIKSHA, listening to radio, podcasts, watching TV channels, etc.
