Astronomy

Some activities included in the Astronomy club are as follows:

Comet making activity:

- This activity provides an opportunity for students to make observations, discuss changing states of matter and demonstrate measuring skills.
- Solar observation is the scientific endeavor of studying the Sun and its behavior and relation to the Earth and the remainder of the Solar System.
- Students were provided with the telescope and trained to prepare solar filters. They were also given information about the other methods for safe solar observation.
- Students learned about how to go through celestial calendar and sky map.
- Finding direction during the day through levelar, compass magnetic needles and finding the sun angles.

Astrophotography:

- is the practice of taking photographs of celestial objects and events, such as stars, the moon, and meteor showers.
- Students were given the information about DSLR camera. Functionality of the DSLR camera and how to capture different pictures.

Hydro Rocket launcher:

A water rocket is a type of model rocket using water as its reaction mass. The water is forced

out by a pressurized gas, typically compressed air. Like all rocket engines, it operates on the

principle of Newton's third law of motion.

Students prepared their own hydro Rockets and they launched their rockets.




